## WHY MUST THE DISTRICT CALL A BOND ELECTION?

1. BCISD has a projected growth of over 400 students during the next 10 years.
2. Current Middle School is approximately 60 years old, and the following has changed since it was built: Safety/Security, State Required Curriculum, Technology, and Energy Efficiencies.
3. Renovating and adding to current Middle School would cost approximately 80% of a new facility.
4. Enrollment in Career and Technical Education (CTE) has greatly increased and will continue to increase.
5. Many CTE classes are currently being held in regular classrooms with inadequate resources.
6. A new CTE Facility will increase the student capacity and educational programs at the High School campus.

## WHAT ARE THE PROPOSED PROJECTS?

### PROPOSITION A

#### NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMPUS



**\$57.7 M**

- Located on district property directly across the street from current MS campus
- 900 student capacity
- Equipped with upgraded safety and security features
- Equipped with updated technology access and infrastructure
- Space for all programs, courses, and support areas, including Media Center, Cafeteria, Fine Arts (Band Hall/Choir/Performance Platform), CTE classes, Science Labs, Athletics (Gymnasiums/Locker Rooms)

### PROPOSITION B

#### NEW CAREER AND TECH (CTE) FACILITY



**\$14.7 M**

- Located on campus behind BCHS
- Alleviates crowded classrooms and provides for growth at BCHS
- CTE programs will move from regular classrooms at BCHS to functional lab settings.
- Allows for continued growth in CTE programs.
- Provides lab settings, classroom space, and storage (as well as a commons area with locker rooms) for the following programs:
